Poundmaker Museum and Gallery and Miyawata Culture Site at Poundmaker Lake

Information for Participants: Space is limited so please register early.

1. The fee per day is \$50/ per day to be paid by etransfer to miyawata.films@gmail.com or pay upon arrival.
2. Snacks and drinks will be provided during the workshop times
3. There will be a dinner break and food provided to participants during the day
4. Participants are required to be responsible for their own accommodations and travel to and from workshop however participants can camp in or around museum which has access to water and washrooms, but no shower and no cooking facilities but does have coffee maker, hot plate and fridge. There is also 2 electrical outlets for RV camping at museum. Rough camping, but safe and secure is also available at the Miyawata Culture site at Poundmaker Lake, about 5 km from the Museum.
5. There are hotel and motels in North Battleford about 70 km away from Poundmaker, or in Cut Knife, which is about 15 km away from Poundmaker.
6. There is 24 hour security on the Poundmaker Cree Nation.
7. Due to the spiritual nature of Plains Indian Sign Language we hope this is respected with a no alcohol or drug policy.
8. We respect all races, creeds, genders and we ask and enforce that there be no jokes, comments or behavior that makes anyone uncomfortable or feel threatened.
9. Please bring your own notebooks and writing material, towels and so on, even utensils such as cups and plates to create less waste of resources.
10. We ask that all participants come here to learn and to focus on that and hopefully walk away with 50-100 Cree words and Signs.
